

Larchmont Charter School Textbook Opt Out Form

Textbook/Ebook Agreement

All students are given access to both a CPM Core Connections Textbook and ebook access through ebooks.cpm.org. Your child has the option to take a textbook home (and have ebook access also) or opt out and use the textbook provided online only at home.

We have textbooks available for in class use.

Your student has chosen to opt out of taking a textbook, but can request a textbook at any time.

Should your child choose to take a textbook, please understand the following:

Books issued to students are the property of Larchmont Charter School. LCS supplies each of its students with books in order to support and enhance learning, and students are allowed to use the books for the duration of the school year. Students are expected to care for books and textbooks and return them in good condition, for use the following year. Books should be covered at all times. Students are not to write, highlight or mark in texts in any way, and books should be kept away from food or drink.

Students who damage or do not return books may not be able to participate in extra curricular activities until such time as the books are returned or Larchmont Charter School is reimbursed for any lost or damaged books. Extra curricular activities are defined as, but not limited to: athletic activities, non-academic field trips, class day ceremonies, graduation ceremony, assemblies, dances, competitions, and clubs.

If books are lost or damaged, a fine will be assessed up to the full replacement cost of the book, which may exceed \$100. The exact replacement value shall be processed through the Head of School or designee. Furthermore, students who do not return books will have report cards and transcripts withheld until any and all fines are paid.

Additionally, students who fail to return books from previous years will not be assigned a book for the current year until the replacement cost is paid. Textbooks are a huge expense; maintaining these texts for as long as possible is a big benefit to our school and Larchmont's budget.
